

**Stratford School Board**  
**Board Meeting**  
**September 12, 2018**

The Stratford School Board had a board meeting on Wednesday, September 12, 2018 at 6:00 pm, at the Stratford Public School in Stratford, NH. Present were: Wayne Hall, Bruce Blodgett and James Kennett. Also present were Superintendent Mike Kelley, Business Administrator Patty Brown and Principal Sandi Adams.

Wayne Hall called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

A motion was made by James Kennett and seconded by Bruce Blodgett to approve the public board minutes of August 22, 2018 as presented. A vote was then taken and all were in favor.

No public comments.

Sandi Adams presented her report and mentioned her enrollment has increased since the board packet was put together; she is up two (2) more students. The total enrollment is currently 66, PreK-8 grades.

Bruce Blodgett asked what the TIGER program was. Sandi explained it's a group that comes in to work with the students on preventing bullying.

Michelle Mason's special education report was presented and Mike Kelley added that we are advertising for an additional special education para professional for school this year.

Shane Cloutier's report was presented and Mike Kelley added that our student information system (SIS) is not working properly and we are looking to replace the software next year.

The board had a few questions about our current SIS program and Mike Kelley responded that our system is not productive and we're looking into other options (companies).

Patty Brown presented her business report with no changes. Patty recommended the board declare the lawn mower surplus, so it could be sold. Patty presented the roof bid and the landscaping bids, she asked the board to take action on the bids so the projects could be completed this fall.

A motion was made by Wayne Hall and seconded by James Kennett to declare the John Deere Lawn Mower as surplus and granted permission to sell it. A vote was then taken; Wayne-YES, James-YES, Bruce-NO. 2-1 majority in favor, motion passes.

A motion was made by Wayne Hall and seconded by Bruce Blodgett to accept the bid from Corbeil Construction to replace the small roof out front to the basement for \$4,300 as presented. A vote was then taken and all were in favor.

A motion was made by Bruce Blodgett and seconded by James Kennett to accept the bid from Wintergreen to complete the landscaping out front for \$5,696 as presented. A vote was then taken and all were in favor.

Mike Kelley presented his report and discussed the meeting on adequacy aid he attended last Thursday in Berlin. The attendance at this meeting was large, over 150 people and there is a PowerPoint available if the board would like to see it.
