Something no one would know about him is that he has written a couple of books and short stories that were published.

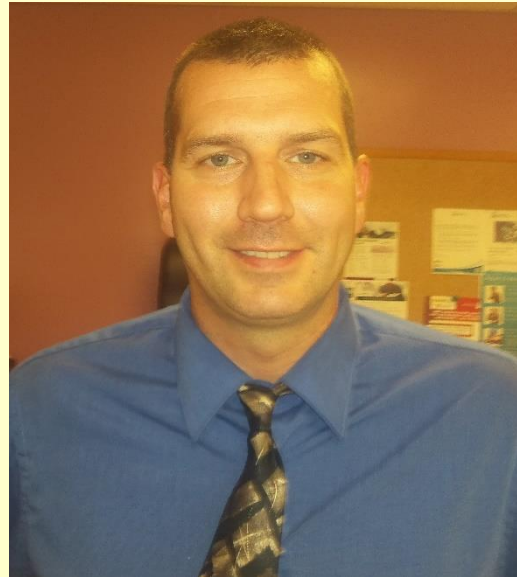


Mallory Langkau
